GENERAL INFORMATION

II. RACE STATUS

1. Latvian Racing Championship is official classified race, included in Latvian Automobile Federation calendar and named as Latvian Racing Championship.
2. Baltic Touring Car Championship - race which execution is based upon agreement between Estonian, Lithuanian and Latvian Automobile federations.

III. RACE CHARACTERISTICS

1. One lap distance: 3662 m
2. Driving direction: clockwise
3. Track cover: asphalt
4. Two races for each class, except class "Division 12" – 1 race
5. Start: standing start for all classes.

V. PARTICIPANTS AND ENTRIES

1. Pre-reception of entries closes 30.04.2010, 16.00
2. The original entry form must be presented during Sporting checks.
3. The number of participants – not limited.
4. Latvian Racing Championship, Baltic Touring Car Championship open for EU ASN's Competitor's and Driver's license holders.
5. **Filled out entry forms should be** delivered to the address below not later than 30.04. 2010 15:00. Entry form must be **sent to:** Latvian Automobile Federation, Brivibas gatve224, Riga, LV1039, Latvia. **Fax. + 371 67551465, or E-mail: laf@laf.lv.**
By submitting entry forms later, the entry fee will be increased by 100 %.
6. By submitting Entry forms competitors declare that:
 - everyone associated with their participation will observe the Regulations;
 - car meets technical regulations;
 - The competitor is held responsible if losing or damaging timing transponder (value – 200, - LVL or 285,- EUR).

VI. ENTRY FEE AND INSURANCE

1. The Organizer has the right to decrease the entry fee or to dismiss it for the teams invited personally.
2. The race is insured by third party insurance.
3. Participant's entry fee must be paid by in cash to the Organizer before the end of sporting checks. If driver is entering in more than one class, the entry fee is decreased by 50% for each class.

VII. ADVERTISING

- 7.1. The advertising stickers will be given by Race organizer during sporting checks and are compulsory for all participants.

VIII. OTHER INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Results of a qualifying, practice and races are published in official announcement board and press center. The decisions of the clerk of the course become valid at the moment they are signed up and located in the announcement board.
2. Parking in the paddock - only with valid passes. Paddock places shall not be booked! The paddock spaces shall be allocated by the organizers according to the order the competitors reach the competition site.
3. All participant's and winners must take part in prize giving ceremony.
4. Pit-line speed is limited at 60 km/h during all practices, warm-up and races.
5. During scrutineering, all practices, warm-up and races the noise level of the cars may be measured. In participating classes in which the noise level is not set, the noise max are set to 110dB/4000 rpm (+/- 200 rpm). That will be measured by FIA method.
6. Crashed or damaged car is allowed back on track only after a scrutineer has given the permission on pit lane exit.
7. Engine silence in Paddock area: 23:00 - 7:00

IX. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

1. Protests and appeals may be made in accordance with Chapters XII and XIII of FIA Sporting Code. Only the competitor has a right to make protest. Representative may also make protest to the clerk of the course under the limits of his authorization. All protests must be made to the clerk of the course and accompanied by the 150,-LVL (215 EUR) fee (sporting protests) or 350,-LVL (500 EUR) technical protest, if dismantling of the car parts is required and confirmed by Chief scrutineer. LAF appellation court fee is set to 700,-LVL (1000 EUR)

X. PRIZE GIVING

1. Event winners are appointed by both race sums. If points are equal, second Race will be decisive.
2. Prize giving is held immediately after last race of the event (according time table).

XI. TIMEKEEPING DEVICES

1. All competition vehicles must carry Organizers timing transponders during the all event. Special affixing joint should be mounted on to the car by the Entrant before Scrutinizing. Transponders must be returned to the timing personal after race finish.
2. During the registration each participant must leave drivers license or identification documents as a guarantee for timing transponder. When the transponder is returned to the time keepers the document will be returned

XII. OTHER INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS

1. During the registration all teams or participants pay 20,-LVL "cleanness and order" deposit. If a team leaves its place clean and ordered and it will be confirmed by organizer's responsible person, this deposit will be returned at the Secretariat after prize giving ceremony. If a team does not leave its zone during two (2) hours after the race, the deposit will not be returned.

XIV. Permits

1. At the time of registration, each participant will be issued the following permits:
 - Entrance pass for access to the Participants Park (**Paddock**) for a car – 1 pass;
 - Entrance pass for Participant's guest car – VIP parking place (**VIP P**);
 - **4 Mechanics** – 4 identity armlets;
 - **For Participant** – 1 identity armlet;
 - **For Competitor's representative** – 1 identity armlet.

In race time all participants must be with armlets issued by the Organizer.

If armlet after 1-st day is broken-down, it will be change at Competition Secretariat.
